Terms and Conditions

1. All courses are checked for viability approximately 5 working days prior to the course date. Should insufficient candidate numbers be obtained then a free course transfer will be offered.
2. Course fees are non- refundable if cancelled within 5 working days of the course date without a medical certificate being produced.
3. All cancellations need to be in writing.
4. If a course needs to be cancelled, each candidate will be telephoned or emailed to advise them of the cancellation and offered a free transfer. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure the correct contact details are provided on the registration form. If messages are left or emailed for candidates regarding course cancellation and candidates arrive at our venue to attend the course that has been cancelled, any expenses incurred by the candidate are wholly their own.
5. Bookings within 5 working days prior to the course date will incur a surcharge of £15 for additional administration costs
6. Home Farm Equestrian Centre are only providing the facilities to enable the BHS syllabus work to be undertaken. The BHS course instructor is responsible for provision of the course content, handouts and instruction.
7. All candidates must act responsibly while on the premises and must stay within the designated areas authorised. While on the premises they must observe speed limits and all warning and directional signage. Buildings and land outside of the training areas are strictly private and prohibited from access.
8. Any accidents, injuries or damage to property must be reported to the BHS course instructor in the first instant.
9. Refreshments can be provided from the in-house catering if required. Candidates are asked to contact us should they require hot food ie bacon / sausage baps during the lunch hour.
